Below are items that need RPD attention:

- Remove danger signs on fence
- Adjust sprinklers, too much water in wrong places
- Flush drinking water line. Still runs rusty
- Hardware at DPA gate on Day Street side replaced with heavy hasp. ADA compliant?
- Signs needed at gates reminding users to keep all gates closed for safety
- Adjust gate between DPA and the field to close wide gaps at hinges and at bottom
- Clean out drains. Full of gravel.
- Permanent benches
- Remove nasty pine suckers behind benches before they grow into the fence

The following items would enhance the dog run and solve problems. Some of these might require us to provide funds and/or do the installation.

- Larger size gravel at 30th Street entrance for better drainage
- Fencing around pine trees to protect from pee.
- Kickboard at bottom of fence to close gap, save balls and gravel
- 3 or 4 foot of material on old fence to limit wind and to cover gaps in gate
- Chicken wire around base of trees in extension to prevent balls and small dogs from going under deck
- Bushes in planters to provide shade for dogs
- Bench under trees in the extension

- 5) Open discussion - issues and input.
